

Neumentix™ Clinical Study Shows Sustained Attention Benefits

Long-term supplementation with botanical ingredient shown to improve focus

DES MOINES, Iowa (November 16, 2017) – New human clinical trial data presented at the Society for Neuroscience on Wednesday, November 15 shows supplementation with patented Neumentix™ Phenolic Complex K110-42 supports sustained attention and focus in young, healthy individuals.

The new study used CNS Vital Signs test to evaluate the effects of Neumentix supplementation on cognitive performance compared to placebo. The CNS test uses a series of computerized neurocognitive tests to assess brain function. Results showed significant improvement in sustained attention after 30 days which lasted through the 90-day study. These results indicate long-term supplementation with Neumentix can improve focus over time.

Neumentix is a water-extracted natural dietary ingredient that was selectively bred to be high in polyphenols and targeted to support cognitive and physical performance.
